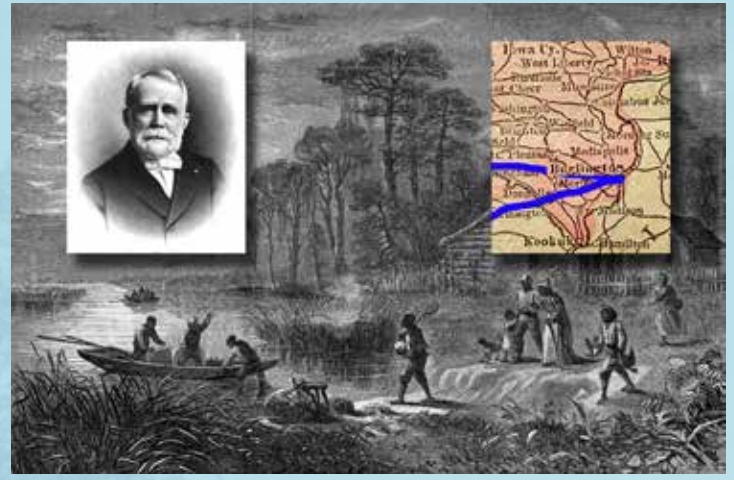

Pre-European

Many Native American tribes called the Upper Mississippi Valley home, including the Meskwaki and Sauk tribes. Prior to European settlement, Burlington was a Meskwaki village called Shoquoquon. Native Americans gathered flint in nearby bluffs to make tools and weapons.



1805

Traveling up the Mississippi River, explorer Zebulon Pike landed in present day Burlington in 1805. Crapo Park, on the south side of the city, is reputed to be the site where he raised the first American flag on Iowa soil.

1821

William Salter, born in 1821, was the minister of Burlington's First Congregational Church for over 60 years. A staunch abolitionist, Salter began assisting escaped enslaved people as soon as the Civil War began, helping establish Burlington as a stop on the Underground Railroad.

1838

Black Hawk, a respected leader and warrior of the Sauk Nation, would winter camp and hold war councils in the area that would later become Burlington. Following the Black Hawk War of 1832, an unsuccessful effort to reclaim tribal lands, the region opened to European settlement. Black Hawk passed away in 1838, leaving a lasting legacy in the history of the Midwest.

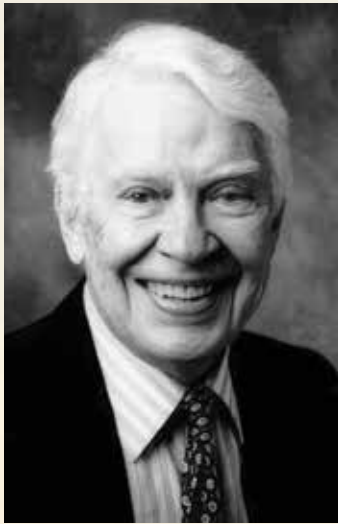


1887

Aldo Leopold, born in Burlington, Iowa in 1887, grew to become one of America's most influential conservationists and environmental philosophers. His work, including *A Sand County Almanac*, continues to inspire global efforts toward ecological awareness and land stewardship.

1894

Burlington's most famous landmark, Snake Alley connects 6th Street between Columbia and Washington Streets and consists of five half-curves and two quarter-curves. Built in 1894 out of limestone and blue clay bricks, the street is reminiscent of vineyard paths in France and Germany.



1915

Bart Howard, born in Burlington, Iowa in 1915, was an accomplished songwriter best known for penning the timeless standard "Fly Me to the Moon." His trademark song, made famous by artists like Frank Sinatra and Peggy Lee, remains one of the most recorded songs of all time.

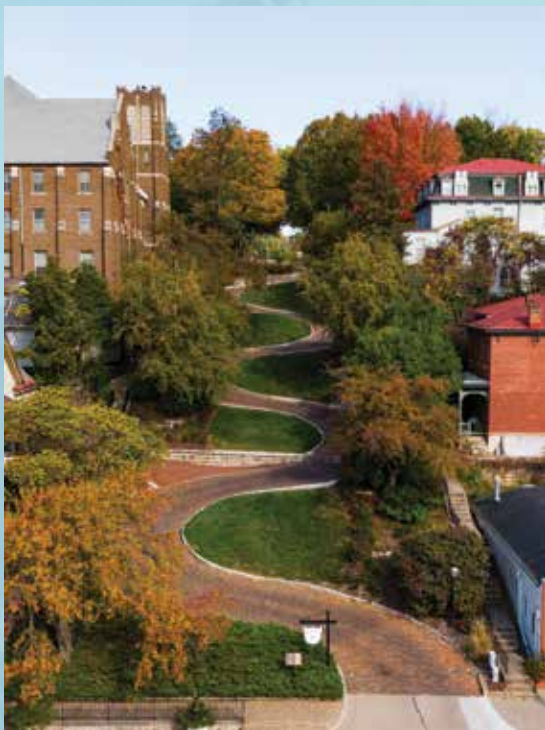
1951

The beloved television classic *Love Lucy* debuted in 1951, capturing hearts across America and transforming the television landscape. Among its unforgettable cast was William Frawley, who portrayed the gruff yet lovable Fred Mertz - and who just so happened to be born in Burlington, Iowa.



1970

Several major railroads – including the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy (CB&Q), Great Northern, Northern Pacific, Spokane, Portland and Seattle, and Pacific Coast railroads – merged in 1970 to form the Burlington Northern Railroad. In 1995, Burlington Northern joined forces with the Santa Fe Railway, creating BNSF Railway, one of the largest freight rail networks in North America.



1983

The Snake Alley Criterium, first held in 1983, is one of the Midwest's most unique and challenging cycling races. The course features the legendary Snake Alley, testing riders' strength and skill while thrilling spectators year after year.



2012

The historic Capitol Theater first opened in 1937 and, after years of restoration, proudly reopened in 2012. Today, it once again hosts live performances, classic films, and special events in a beautifully restored Art Deco setting.

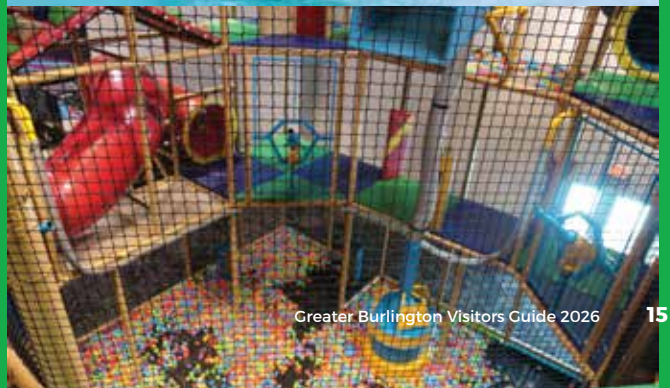

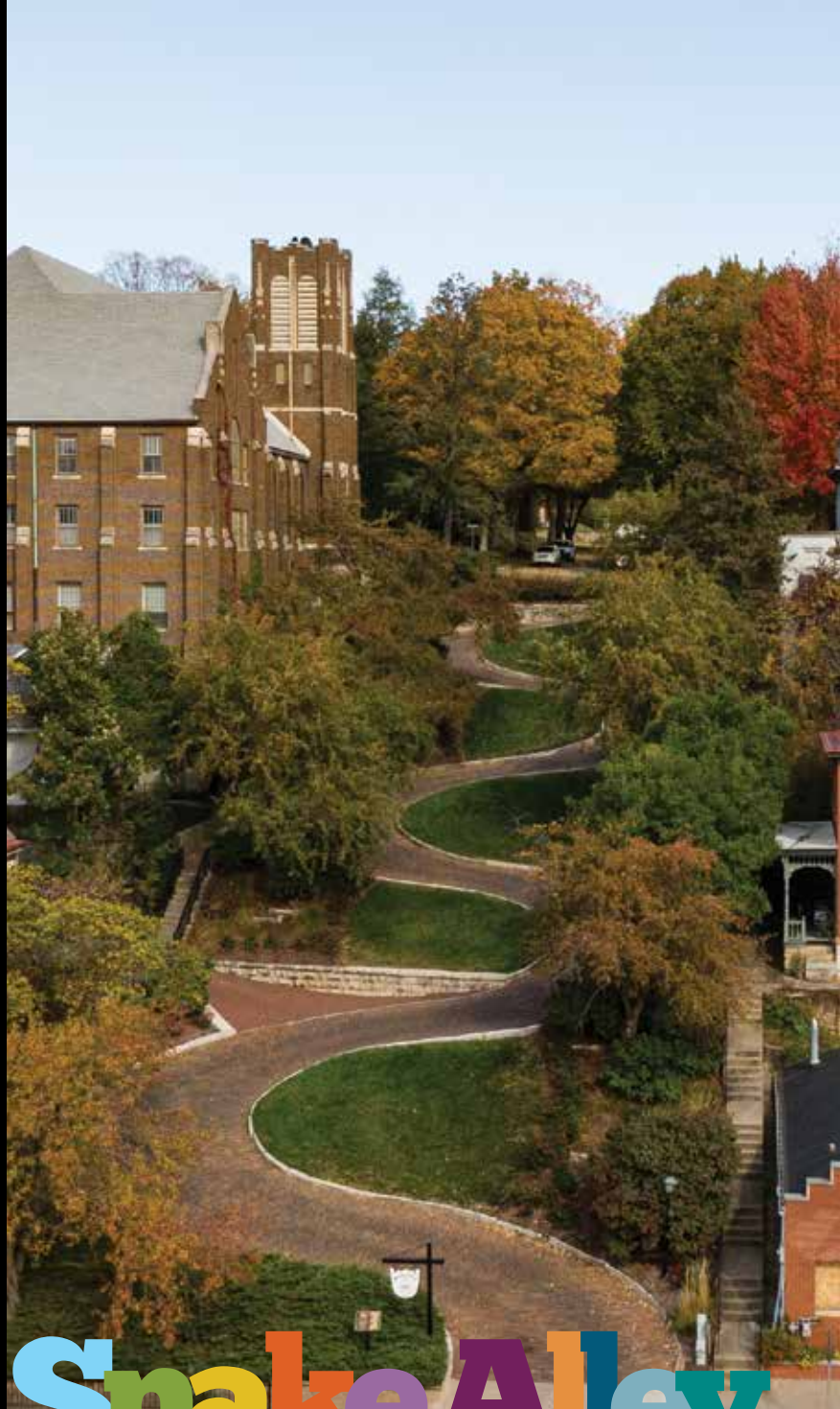

Snake Alley

Greater Burlington's Snake Alley was built in 1894 to solve a practical problem: how to link the steep hillside neighborhood on Heritage Hill to the bustling downtown business district. Three German-trained designers emulated vineyard paths in France and Germany, crafting a winding brick and limestone street, including five half-curves and two quarter-curves, that rises 58.3 feet over a 275-foot stretch. Over time it became a quirky piece of engineering history and beloved local landmark that is open to motor and pedestrian traffic.

to Greater Burlington embrace a landscape rich with natural beauty, scenic waterways, and year-round recreation. Situated along the mighty Mississippi River, the region offers an abundance of adventures for outdoor enthusiasts of every stripe, whether you're seeking peaceful moments in nature or active, high-energy exploration.

Fishing is a favorite pastime, thanks to the river's legendary reputation and the area's many lakes and streams. Anglers can cast for a variety of species along the Mississippi or enjoy the calm waters of Big Hollow Recreation Area, a beloved destination featuring a well-stocked lake perfect for both fishing and boating. Big Hollow also caters to campers with RV and tent sites, making it an excellent base for multi-day getaways filled with hiking, paddling, and picnicking.

Hikers will find no shortage of inspiring terrain. Starr's Cave Park & Preserve is a standout gem: 184 acres of limestone bluffs, unique geological formations, and wooded pathways. Its two miles of trails wind through quiet forest and along Flint Creek, offering a glimpse of natural features found nowhere else in the world. Geode State Park provides even more opportunities to stretch your legs, with miles of scenic trails, peaceful lake views, and water activities including canoeing and kayaking.

Closer to the heart of Burlington, visitors can explore two signature parks that highlight the community's long connection to the outdoors. Historic Crapo Park features an arboretum, river overlooks, and shady walking paths, while neighboring Dankwardt Park is home to athletic fields, picnic shelters, and a popular disc golf course.

Cyclists and walkers alike enjoy the network of trails that connect many of these outdoor spaces, making it easy to experience the best of the Greater Burlington area at your own pace. Whether biking riverfront paths or hiking wooded bluffs, every outing provides fresh air, scenic views, and the satisfying sense of discovery.

Spring/Summer



As the weather warms and the days grow longer, Greater Burlington comes alive with opportunities to explore the outdoors. Miles of hiking and biking trails, stretching through favorites like the Flint River Trail, Starr's Cave Park & Preserve, Big Hollow Recreation Area, and Hunt Woods, invite visitors to immerse themselves in spring blooms, lush summer greenery, and the gentle sounds of nature.

Boaters, canoers, and kayakers find plenty to love as well, whether paddling across the 178-acre lake at Big Hollow or launching from the accessible ramps at Geode State Park. Anglers can cast a line at Big Hollow Lake, the Linder Conservation Area, or the 4th Pumping Station, while the Mississippi River offers endless prime fishing waters just minutes from downtown. Golfers can enjoy long, sunny days on the fairways of Spirit Hollow and Flint Hills Municipal Golf Course.

Autumn/Winter

When fall arrives, Greater Burlington transforms into a landscape painted with brilliant reds, golds, and deep oranges. Leaf peepers flock to Mosquito Park, the Crapo Park arboretum, and the scenic overlook at Starr's Cave Park & Preserve for some of the most breathtaking views in the region.

Cooler temperatures also make autumn perfect for hiking, photography, and peaceful afternoons spent exploring the riverfront. As winter settles in, the outdoor fun continues for those willing to bundle up. The Flint River Trail becomes a serene spot for cross-country skiing, while Big Hollow Lake and Lake Geode draw ice fishing enthusiasts. Hunters also appreciate the area's outstanding seasonal opportunities. And no winter visit is complete without viewing the bald eagles that gather along the Mississippi River - most notably near Lock & Dam 18 and Sullivan Slough Road - creating one of Greater Burlington's most iconic cold-weather experiences.
