Integra Pool Covers has committed to 40 of the positions being at or above the wage threshold. The company is also looking to take advantage of the Iowa Industrial New Jobs Training program which is administered through Southeastern Community College, and provides financial assistance for new employee training.

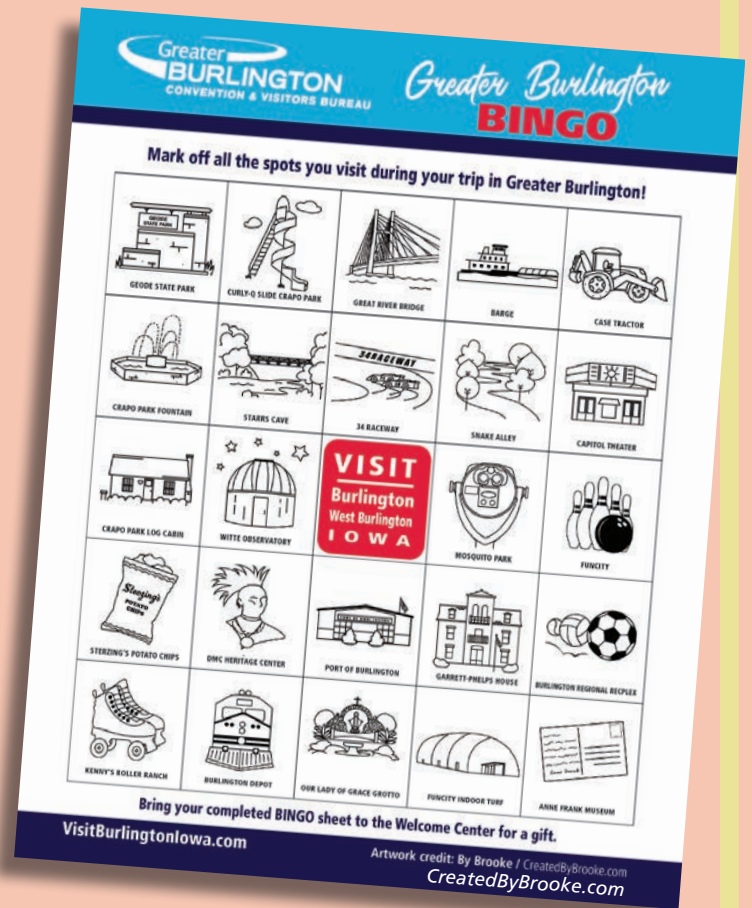
