Burlington/West Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce 5 Star Accredited - Again!

The Greater Burlington Partnership has once again received the prestigious 5 Star Accreditation designation by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce, placing the organization in the top 1.5% of Chambers in the United States with the highest honor awarded. Accreditation with the U.S. Chamber of Commerce is the only program of its kind that defines excellence in chamber planning and recognizes local chambers of commerce for their outstanding contributions towards positive change in their communities.

Currently there are only 190 chambers that carry the Accreditation distinction. With more than 7,000 chambers in the country, earning the U.S. Chamber 5 Star Accreditation is an honor that distinguishes the high quality, expertise and strong leadership displayed by an Accredited local Chamber of Commerce. In order to achieve this distinction, the Greater Burlington Partnership met or exceeded required standards in operations and programs including areas of governance, finance, facilities, member programs, government relations, marketing, and technology.

Local and regional chambers are rated "Accredited," "Accredited with 3 Stars," "Accredited with 4 Stars," or "Accredited with 5 Stars." State chambers are rated "Accredited State Chamber," or "Accredited State Chamber with Distinction." The final determination is made by the accrediting board, a committee of U.S. Chamber board members, and chamber CEOs from across the country. The U.S. Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors awarded 11 chambers of commerce, including the Greater Burlington Partnership, at its March meeting.

"Now more than ever, chambers of commerce have stepped up to serve as a resource to the business community and advocates of free enterprise" said Raymond P. Towle, IOM, CAE, U.S. Chamber Vice President of Federation Relations and Institute for Organization Management. "Through the pandemic these chambers continue to lead while maintaining transparent governance practices, sound financial controls, safe work environments, value in programming and effective communications. They are commended for their sound policies and practices, and for this great accomplishment."

The Greater Burlington Partnership received special recognition for the Transforming the Talent Pipeline and Greater Burlington Leadership programs, and for the efforts to provide information, tools, and guidance to the Greater Burlington business community while navigating through the COVID-19 pandemic.
