TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 01/FRI: CHICAGO – MADRID

Please arrive in time at Chicago International Airport to board your overnight flight to Madrid. Enjoy in-flight meals and services.

DAY 02/SAT: MADRID ARRIVAL

Welcome to Madrid! Upon arrival at Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in.

Overnight in Madrid



Optional: Madrid Essential Segway Tour: \$50 per person SIC basis

Departure Time & Meeting Point: The tour does not include hotel pickup. Please arrive at 6PM at Calle Escalinata 10, in front of Plaza de Isabel II (also known as Plaza de Ópera), close to the McDonald's Restaurant.

Explore Madrid's most emblematic monuments on a Segway tour. After a brief training by an experienced guide, you're off to slide through the city highlights. The first stops will be at Plaza de Santiago and Plaza de Ramales, from where you will slide towards Plaza de Oriente. See the impressive Royal Palace and the beautiful Almudena Cathedral. Glide down Mayor Street and learn about the city history on this itinerary that will take you to the main squares in town. Admire the gastronomic temple the Mercado de San Miguel is and reach the Plaza Mayor. Continue to Puerta del Sol and see the emblematic Spanish "Km0" and the statue of the Oso and the Madrone, symbol of the city. The itinerary finishes at the same departure point

DAY 03/ SUN: MADRID (B/-/-)

This morning after breakfast, enjoy a panoramic tour of Madrid. You will discover the medieval origins of the city with its Arabic Fortress at the Barrio de la Morería, famous for its historic buildings. Drive through the courtesan district of the Hapsburgs characterized by Phillip II and its Renaissance and Baroque style buildings, Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor, and Plaza de la Villa; the Madrid of the Bourbons and the complex town planning schemes of Charles III, the Royal Palace, Cibeles and Neptuno Fountains, and the Puerta de Alcalá. Admire the 19th-century work including the Prado Museum. From there explore contemporary Madrid the areas of Gran Vía, Castellana, the district of Salamanca, Plaza Castilla, and Parque del Oeste, as well as the commercial and financial areas of Modern Madrid, the emblematic Las Ventas Bull Ring, and the Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium. Spend the afternoon at leisure to explore the wonders this city has to offer.

Flamenco Show at "Tablao La Carmela with Drink

Enjoy the true art of flamenco at Tablao La Carmela. Located very close of Puerta del Sol, in the old coal cellars of the Taberna "La Carmela" (former

Convent of La Victoria, demolished in 1836 after the War of Independence). Every night the best dancers (known as bailaoras) come to the Tablao La Carmela, who will make you enjoy this art in each of their shows.

DAY 04/MON: MADRID – CORDOBA - SEVILLE (B/-/-)

After breakfast drive south through the land of Don Quixote's the Man from La Mancha. Along the way, you will breathtaking vast vineyards. There will be a brief stop in Puerto Lapice before crossing through the Despeñaperros (a natural gorge) into Andalucía, a region with a fascinating past. Upon arrival in Cordoba, head on a tour of the impressive Mosque and other magnificent sites with the opportunity to stroll through the narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter. This afternoon, after a short two-hour drive, we will arrive in Seville.

Overnight in Seville

DAY 05/TUE: SEVILLE (B/-/-)

This morning, enjoy a panoramic tour of Seville including the Cathedral, the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peter's in Rome. You will discover the Santa Cruz Quarter, a natural scenescape for the opera "Carmen" and where the myth of "Don Juan" developed, the Maria Luisa Park, and Spain Square. Spend the afternoon at leisure to discover Seville.

Overnight in Seville

Optional: Guadalquivir Cruise: \$45 per person SIC basis

Departure / Meeting Time: Please arrive at Wharf of Marqués del contadero, closet o Torre del Oro.

Visit Seville from a unique position and enjoy privileged views from Guadalquivir River of the Triana district, the bullring, or the bridges, among others. A sailing experience along the river that offers you an idyllic view of the unique and inimitable Seville.

Feel the history of Seville from a magical perspective that not everyone can enjoy, go with the river current under the bridges and gaze at the beautiful skyline of a unique and inimitable city.



DAY 06/WED: SEVILLE – GRANADA (B/-/-)

After breakfast, we will head east into the heart of Andalucía, observing an endless number of olive trees on the way to Granada — the last stronghold of the Moorish Kingdoms until 1492. Visit the world-famous Alhambra Palace and discover the Generalife Gardens. This is a breathtaking setting that has inspired many authors, including W. Irving in his work "Tales of the Alhambra". Spend your afternoon at leisure.

Overnight in Granada

Optional: Albaicín & Sacromonte Walking Tour: \$50 per person SIC basis

Departure/ Meeting Time: Please arrive by 6Pm at Plaza Isabel La Católica

On this guided tour, you will discover corners of Granada with a lot of history. Travel back in time in Albaicín, where you will experience its Moorish roots firsthand, and in Sacromonte, the neighborhood where the gypsies who fought with the Catholic Monarchs settled



DAY 07/THU: GRANADA – VALENCIA (B/-/-)

Today we will drive towards the Mediterranean coast. Travel via Murcia, the capital of the fertile region of the Segura River, before continuing north via Alicante, the second-largest city within the autonomous region of Valencia. We will reach Valencia, home to the modern Arts and Sciences Architectural Complex. Valencia is also the home to the well-known and delicious "Paella".

Overnight in Valencia

DAY 08/FRI: VALENCIA – BARCELONA (B/-/-)

This morning on your panoramic tour of Valencia, drive through the old city seeing the most prominent buildings in the area. Head past the old riverbed of the Turia to the most avant-garde complex, the Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias. Early this afternoon, continue north along the Mediterranean to Catalunya, via Tarragona, the Roman Tarraco, and on to Barcelona, the breathtaking capital of Spain's Catalonia region, known for its art and architecture. Discover the fantastical Sagrada Familia church and other modernist landmarks designed by Antoni Gaudí along with its spectacular shopping and nightlife.

Overnight in Barcelona



DAY 09/SAT: BARCELONA (B/-/-)

Enjoy a morning tour of Barcelona, well known for the 1992 Olympic Games. Drive along the main avenues with impressive modernist buildings by Gaudí such as La Pedrera and Casa Milá, both declared World Heritage buildings. You will see Montjuïc Park with spectacular views of the city and harbor. The panoramic tour includes seeing the Olympic Rings, the monument to Columbus, and the Olympic Port. Spend the afternoon at leisure to continue your discovery of this exciting city.
