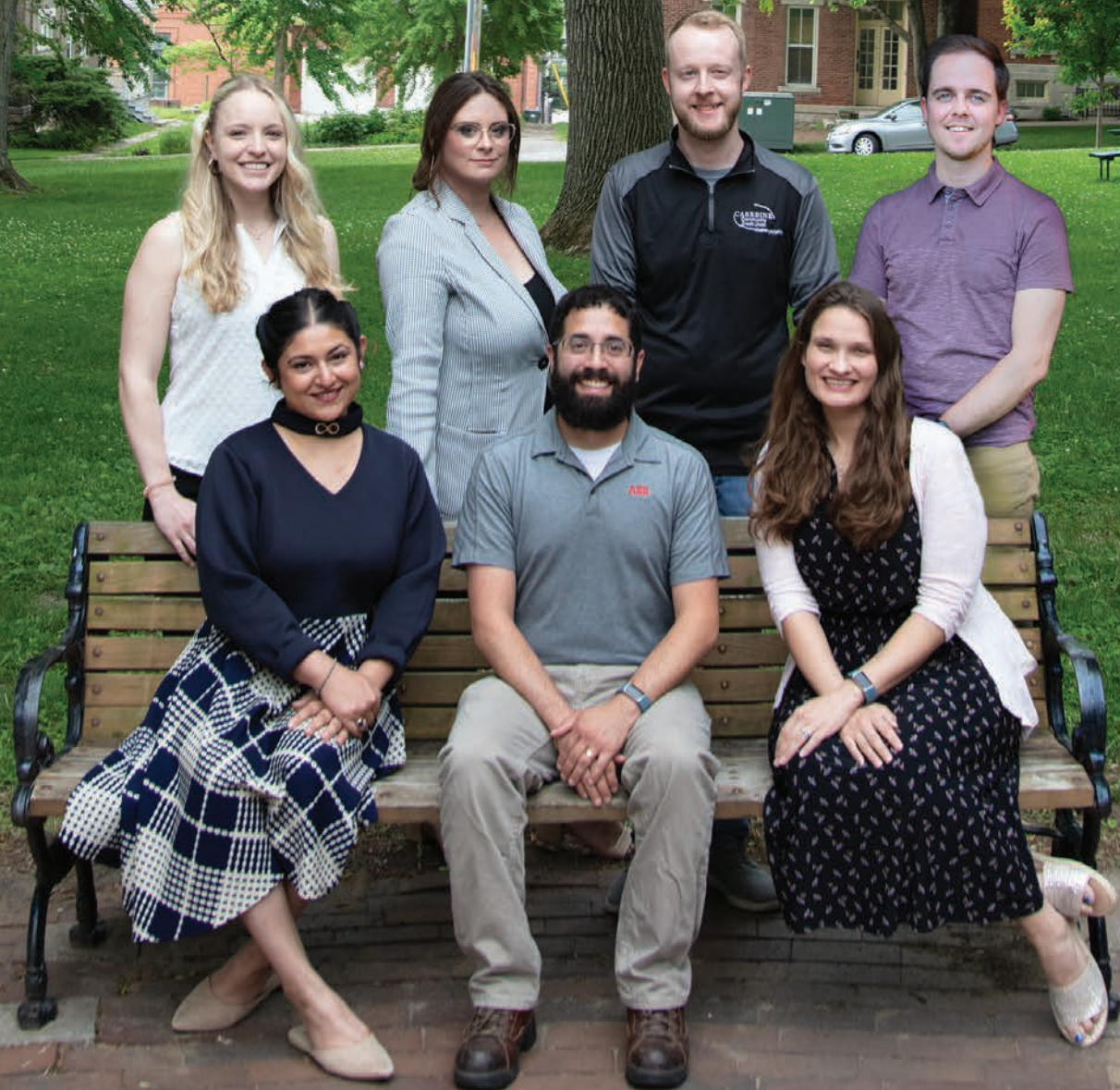

DES MOINES COUNTY HOUSING NEEDS ASSESSMENT, SURVEYS UNDERWAY

The Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission (SEIRPC) and the Greater Burlington Partnership (GBP) are conducting a County-Wide Housing Needs Assessment for Des Moines County, including each community and the rural areas of the county. The Assessment will highlight current demographic and economic statistical data, local housing unit "target demand" and a five year "Housing Action Plan" for new housing development and existing housing rehabilitation activities. The Southeast Iowa Regional Planning Commission and the Greater Burlington Partnership are being assisted by Hanna:Keelan Associates, P.C., a Lincoln, Nebraska-based community planning and research consulting firm.

A series of citizen participation programs and surveys are being implemented in Des Moines County to gather information regarding housing strengths, issues, opportunities and needs in the county. The survey process, which concludes on July 15, includes the following opportunities for local input:

- A "County-Wide Housing Survey" is now available to all citizens of the county and surrounding area. Topics include identifying barriers/impediments to fair and affordable housing, identification of county-wide housing needs and support for utilizing local, state and federal grant dollars for housing development and rehabilitation programs. The survey is available on the Greater Burlington Partnership website and on the Southeast Iowa Regional Planning (SEIRPC) website, as well as other local websites and social media outlets.
- A "Workforce Housing Needs Survey" is available to persons employed at select businesses and industries in Des Moines County. The survey will identify workforce housing needs and wants among local employees.
- An "Employer Housing Assistance Survey" is available to Presidents/CEOs and other major employer representatives to identify existing housing partnership and support programs being offered, as well as potentially creating public-private partnerships for the implementation of new housing-related programs.
- A "Housing Stakeholder Survey" is available to providers of specialized housing facilities and services (skilled nursing/assisted living, developmental disabilities, emergency housing, temporary & homeless shelters, Housing Authority, etc.), as well as local housing developers, contractors, and funding organizations. The goal of this survey is to identify housing needs for specific populations and creating partnerships for new housing development and implementation programs in Des Moines County.

Surveys will be available for participation through July 15.

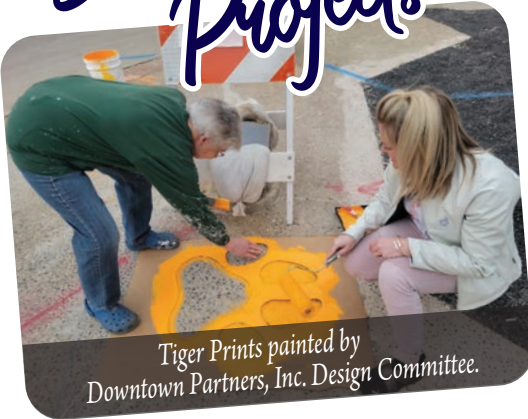

Downtown Burlington is seeing a boom in projects. TIGER Project work continues on the Riverfront, the 700 - 800 blocks of Jefferson and on Main Street. Tama Too is going up quickly on the 300 block of Jefferson Street. Churchill Building is almost complete and getting

ready to open as residential and commercial space. Merge Urban Development Group is ready to start building on 3rd Street. The 700 block of Jefferson Street is undergoing exciting renovations. The Burlington Apartments on the corner of 3rd Street and Valley Street is having tuckpoint work being done to the façade of the building. There are many upper story renovations happening and commercial space is being created throughout the Downtown District.

Although you may not be able to park in front of your favorite business when construction work is on that block, remember that there is parking on the side streets and in the city lots. In most cases, you can park less than a block away and walk to support the small businesses.
