ADVOCACY EFFORTS AT THE U.S. CAPITOL

The Greater Burlington Partnership advocates for economic vitality and regional priorities to Iowa's U.S. Senators and Congressional officials, the Administration, and their staffs. During the Southeast Iowa delegation trip to Washington, D.C. this month, Partnership staff and Greater Burlington community leaders will continue to highlight the Partnership's priorities, including:

Transportation & Infrastructure

- The completion of Highway 34 corridor as four lanes in Illinois.
- The continuation of the Airport Improvement Program, Essential Air Service (EAS), Small Community Air Service Development Grants, and the Non-Primary Entitlement (NPE) program funds. These programs develop and maintain facilities at airports, such as Southeast Iowa Regional Airport in Burlington, and support commercial air service.
- Port developments on the Mississippi River, specifically the Mid-America Intermodal Regional Port project in Quincy, IL, and the authorization of the Upper Mississippi and Illinois Rivers Comprehensive Plan.
- To continue investment in broadband infrastructure. Recognizing the nature of today's telecommunications market should include the avoidance of over-regulation, incentivizing the private sector investment, and fostering public-private partnerships.
- The Federal Government's renewable fuel standard and encourage expanded utilization of E15.
- Addressing the national pilot shortage and its impacts on Southeast Iowa Regional Airport.

Economic Development

- Retention of Historic Preservation Tax Credits. These vital federal incentives are proven tools that Greater Burlington has leveraged for more than \$45 million in private investment while preserving our communities' historic properties.
- Relief for supply chain and inflationary pressures.

Events must take place between July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023.

Applications are reviewed by the Greater Burlington Sports Commission, and selected partners are included on the Convention & Visitors Bureau's application for funding to the Iowa Economic Development Authority.

The Collective Food Hub



The Greater Burlington Partnership had a field day with small business on May 6 at the Fun City Turf. Members enjoyed breakfast items and mingled with friends around many booths, promoting their services and offering fun games to play. After hearing from Grow Greater Burlington Executive Director Jeremy Hess, it was time to announce the Small Business of the Year Award to **The Collective Food Hub**.

Their business has grown tremendously since being purchased in 2021, with weekly sales doubling by the end of the year. Their customer base has grown by leaps and bounds and they have new customers coming in every week.

Their location at 805 Jefferson St is filled with completely homemade delectables, farm fresh produce, and locally sourced meat and eggs. They have also added take-n-bake meals and just recently started dabbling with small venue catering. It offers a shared use kitchen that is available to rent

for the general public or for people who want to bake goods that are then available for sale on the attached retail floor.

All excess product is donated at the end of the week to St Vincent de Paul Food Pantry. A generous amount of items have been donated to a cancer benefit for a local individual with other benefits scheduled for the coming year. They have been very generous with sponsorships, including the Greater Burlington Partnership, with the mission to help better promote the community. They have also had a special needs person using the kitchen and retail space for his products as part of a Vocational Rehab program.

Main Street Iowa Challenge Grant

Iowa's Downtowns are prospering with an expanding number of business, residential, and cultural investments. To continue this momentum, the Iowa Economic Development Authority has created the Main Street Challenge Grant for brick and mortar projects.

Main Street Iowa communities, including Burlington, may apply for the Main Street Challenge Grant. Eligible projects must be within the Downtown District. They can include building rehabilitations, facade improvements, new construction, or reuse projects. Plans will be locally judged on preservation standards, architectural significance, and impact on the community.

Local applications are due July 1, with State application due Sept 2. If you are interested or you know someone who is, please visit Greater Burlington Partnership for more details.

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Maximum grant awards will be \$100,000. Minimum grant awards will be no less than \$25,000 per project.
- A 1:1 match is required. In-kind contributions are permitted for no more than 35% of the project match. Other federal or state grant program awards may not be used to satisfy the cash match for the project/property. In-kind matches must be documented, professional services.
- Building projects must be located within the local Main Street District boundaries as of January 1, 2022.
- The local Main Street program must be the grant applicant on behalf of the property owner(s). Only one application per local Main Street program is allowed.

The TIGER Project is "roaring" down Jefferson Street, Main Street and the Riverfront. Work continues on Main Street, Jefferson Street and the Riverfront with concrete removal, force main installation and sidewalk improvements with utility work also being completed. Visible new improvements are foundations for the solar shade structure and parking lot striping at the Riverfront.

Although you may not be able to park in front of your favorite business when construction work is on that block, remember that there is parking on the side streets and in the city lots. In most cases, you can park less than a block away and walk to support the small businesses. The DPI Design Committee has been out painting "TIGER" prints to lead you to your favorite eateries, drinkeries and businesses in the Downtown.

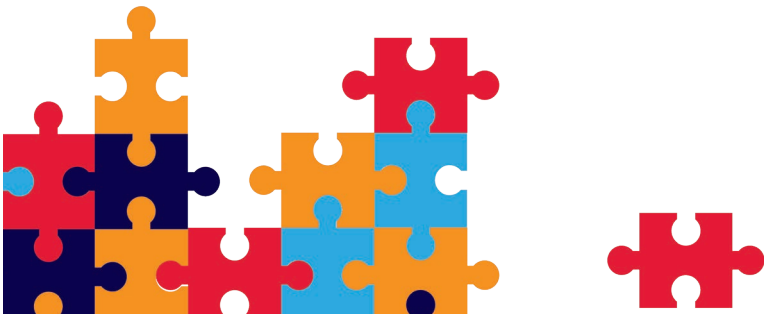
