Important Measures on the Ballot November 2

Election Day is Tuesday, November 2. Voted early? Fantastic. If not, be sure to get to the polls on November 2. Every election is important and this year is no different.

For Burlington residents, the local option sales tax referendum, frequently referred to as Pennies for Progress, is on the ballot. It is important for this measure to pass. The Local Option Sales Tax has been in effect for many years in both the cities of Burlington and West Burlington. But for Burlington, the Local Option Sales Tax is placed before the voters every ten years for a referendum vote.

Why is it important to maintain this source of revenue? Fifty percent of the revenue generated by Pennies for Progress is used to provide property tax relief. The funding also supports eight law enforcement positions. The remaining money is used for street maintenance and for economic development. It is noteworthy that a significant portion of the local sales tax is paid by nonresidents who shop in Greater Burlington, as well as by tourists. As Greater Burlington has continued to grow as a regional shopping hub, the total revenue from the Local Option Sales Tax has also grown. This growth has been to the advantage of Burlington residents as they benefit from the property tax relief and expanded law enforcement.

Local Option Sales Tax has a long and impactful history in Burlington:

First adopted in 1994, renewed in 1997, 2002 and 2012

- 50% For Property Tax Relief
- Additional Police Officers
- Squad cars for Police Department
- Capital Projects
- Economic Development

The question?

Shall the City of Burlington, Iowa, levy a one percent sales tax to be effective January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2032, of which at least 50% of the proceeds shall be used for property tax relief. The remainder of the sales tax proceeds shall be used for public safety, capital improvements, capital equipment, debt obligations and economic development.

The Answer: Vote YES

GET OUT AND VOTE



The 2021 election is here. The Government Relations Committee hosted candidate forums for local contested races. Check out GreaterBurlington.com and Greater Burlington Partnership on Facebook for the forums.

On August 17, the Burlington/West Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce, Grow Greater Burlington, Downtown Partners Board of Directors and Greater Burlington Convention & Visitors Steering Committee voted to support the passage of the City of Burlington Local Option Sales Tax continuation for another 10 years.

The Local Option Sales Tax has been in effect for many years providing 50% of the proceeds to be used for property tax relief. The remainder of the sales tax proceeds will be used for public safety, including eight police officers, capital improvements & equipment,

debt obligations and economic development. The sales tax provides a way for nonresidents to support the costs of providing services which they utilize during their visits and provides some relief for property taxpayers. In Fiscal Year 2020 the income generated from Local Option Sales Tax was \$4.3 million. The City of Burlington estimates the revenue generated for Fiscal Year 2021 to be \$4.8 million.

With this vote of support, the Pennies for Continued Progress Committee was formed to promote the local option sales tax ballot issue.

Vote YES for the renewal of Local Option Sales Tax in Burlington.

2021 Manufacturer of the Year STERZING FOOD COMPANY

The 2021 Manufacturer of the Year is a seasoned favorite throughout Greater Burlington.

Sterzing Food Company has seen many challenges, changes, and growth in the past few years. A large hurdle was placed in front of Sterzing's when an FDA ruling required them to change the formula for their cooking oil which had been the same recipe for over five decades. However, more than a year of testing and blending of oils finally resulted in a formula that closely matched the original recipe. Over time, the confidence of their loyal fans was gained once again.

Adversity often leads to diversity. While Sterzing Food Co. was testing and trying new oils to match their original formula, they retooled the manufacturing portion of their factory with a multi-million dollar upgrade in 2018. Two new industrial fryers were installed that would best mimic the cooking process that Sterzing Food Company founder Barney Sterzing had perfected in 1933. The new equipment would eliminate several cooking jobs but would create more packing positions as the facility became more efficient. No jobs were lost during the upgrade but several positions were added.

In addition, the new equipment allowed for the creation of two new flavors and the expansion of other lines of business. BBQ Sterzing's was added in 2019 and in the summer of 2021, on the

anniversary of their 10 years of ownership, Craig and Gary debuted the Sour Cream and Onion flavored chips which has become a tremendous hit with Sterzing's fans.

As a food manufacturer, Sterzing Food Company prides itself on giving entry level employees second and third chances to succeed. Another huge blessing is the retention of several employees with over 30 years of employment with the company, which keeps business relationships stable.

Adapting to change in the business world is not easy, but recent changes of Sterzing Food Company appear to have brought significant opportunities and stability to this small local manufacturer. Without loyal customers, any job can become disheartening. But hearing from their fans about how excited they are to have Sterzing's back, and just as good or even better than before, makes their work very rewarding for this hometown favorite. Congratulations to Sterzing Food Company!

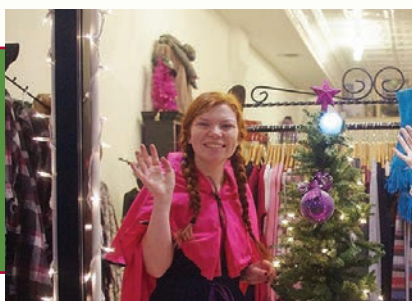

TIGER Grant Update . . .

The TIGER Project is moving forward. The City of Burlington was awarded a \$17.5 million Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery grant in 2018, with plans to use the money to revamp the Riverfront and Main and Jefferson streets in the Downtown District. City council awarded the bid for both projects to Dubuque-based construction company, Portzen Construction, Inc. Work has started on the Riverfront and 800 block of Jefferson Street.

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
