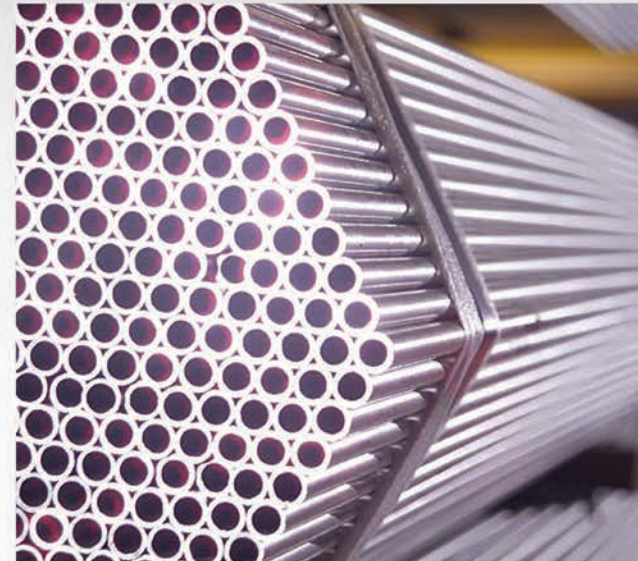

OCTOBER IS MANUFACTURING APPRECIATION MONTH

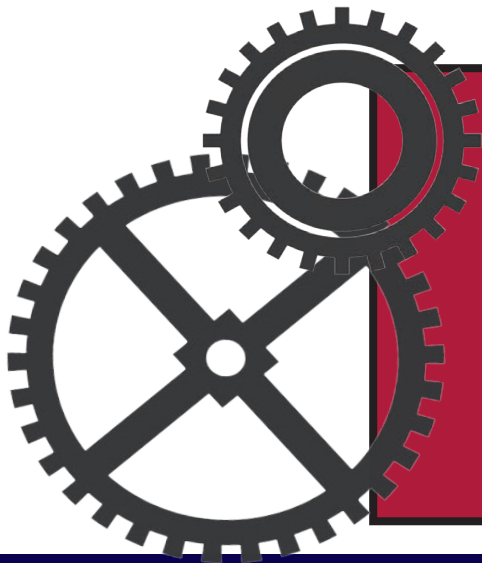
Greater Burlington has long been recognized as a center of manufacturing. Residents are familiar with the longstanding presence of CNH, American Ordnance, Flint

Cliffs Manufacturing, USG, Big River Resources, KPI Concepts and Winegard. The local manufacturing industries also include Italian-based COBO- USA, Borghi USA, and Alfagomma. In more recent years the area has welcomed Silgan and Deep Root Irrigation. Statewide food production accounts for 22% of all manufacturing, with local companies such as Shearer's, Sterzing Food Company, TriOakFoods, and soon to open Western Smokehouse Partners contributing to the sector.

Their collective impact on the local economy is substantial. More than 4,000 people in Greater Burlington are employed in the manufacturing sector, ensuring the food supply chain, national defense, infrastructure, agriculture, communication, technology, housing and more. Due to the skilled workforce in Des Moines County and surrounding areas, these facilities operate in innovative ways, improving efficiencies, safety, and maintaining high levels of production. Materials and finished products made here in Greater Burlington are shipped all around the world.

Statewide, manufacturers in Iowa account for 17.36% of the total output in the state, employing 16% of the workforce. In 2019, the total output from manufacturing was \$33.80 billion. In addition, the manufacturing sector provides 271,000 jobs, with an average annual compensation of \$72,750.57 in 2019.

October is Manufacturing Appreciation Month. The Greater Burlington Partnership salutes this important sector of the local business community and continues to advocate for an environment where manufacturing can flourish.
